

Grace Summer Camp Information and Parent Consent

Summer Camps - 2021

Grace College summer camps will incorporate the following policies and procedures for hosting all boys and girls summer camps on Grace campus. We are excited to be able to offer summer camps this year and we are putting practices into place to ensure the safety of all campers and staff.

All summer campers will not be required to test prior to attending any Grace College camp unless they have been exposed to someone who tested positive in the past 14 days prior to the camp. Masks will not be required to be worn by campers or by parents attending evening games. There will be a waiver that must be signed by all parents for their son or daughter to attend Grace summer camp.

Summer Camp Daily Symptom Check:

- All campers and counselors will be symptom & temperature checked each day. This is for both day camps and overnight camps.
- If any camper does not pass the daily symptom temperature check the parent or guardian will be required to pick up their camper immediately.
- Any camper that is required to leave camp due to not passing their symptom check will be required to show documentation to have received a negative covid test to return to camp.
- If any camper who has been removed from camp receives a positive test result, the camp director will be immediately notified and the roommate for the camper will be required to leave camp immediately.
- Contact tracing will take place after a positive test has been received, which may also affect some campers remaining at camp.

Summer Camp Overnight Housing:

- Campers will not be allowed to switch rooms or add anyone to a room without camp director permission.
- Rooms are allowed to house 2 campers in each dorm room.
- Campers who attend any overnight camp are allowed to leave at any time to stay at home if desired.

Summer Camp Financials:

- A parent may choose not to have their camper tested if the camper must leave camp due to a failed daily symptom check. All summer camp refunds will be on a prorated basis. They will not be able to return to camp without a negative test result.
- If a camper leaves a camp due to their roommate-testing positive for covid – the summer camp refund will be issued on a prorated basis.
- Any camper who is contact traced due to a positive test result will have the opportunity to get tested and with a negative test result may return to camp. If they are unable to return all summer camp refunds will be issued on a prorated basis.
- Campers who pay to attend any overnight camp are allowed to leave at any time to stay at home if desired. There will be no refund for not staying overnight in the dorm.
- All covid testing will be at the cost of the camper.

Evening Attendance Summer Camps:

- Parents are able to attend evening games but social distancing will be encouraged.

Medical Concerns/Allergies

Medications - If a camper takes medication, they will be responsible for their medication and for taking their medication. If you have concerns, the coach may keep the medication in the camp office and the camper can access each day
